

Student Activity Account Policy

The Band Booster organization actively provides opportunities for students to earn monies for sponsored events through specific fundraisers. Students earn monies to help underwrite the cost of activities not financed through school district funds. Student financial account records are maintained by the Band Booster organization. Parents will be notified of this policy annually in the newsletter. Account fund balance can be requested at any time.

Funds that individual students earn will be handled as follows:

- ? Monies that students raise from grades 7-12 will remain in the student's account until graduation, provided they remain active in band.
 - * The Band Director will notify the Band Booster organization of students who have dropped Band or who have moved from the district. These monies will be transferred to the Band Booster General Fund.
- ? Monies can be used by students to offset expenses for any band sponsored trip.
 - **Band sponsored trips at this time include: Disney, Mini Senior Band trip and Middle School "Music in the Parks", Marine Band Trip) Requests for other trips to be considered are at the discretion of the Band Boosters.
- ? Monies in student accounts can be applied to Band Booster sponsored events.
- ? Monies in student accounts can be applied to parents acting as chaperones or for immediate family fees as tagalongs for band trips. (The Disney trip is the only trip at this time that offers tagalong seating.)
 - (Immediate family consists of: Parents/Guardian, siblings and grandparents)**
- ? Monies in senior (12th grade) accounts can be applied to fees associated with the Annual Banquet **(for the senior student and immediate family members only)** and the yearly DVD.
- ? Monies remaining in senior student accounts upon graduation will automatically transfer to the Band Booster General Fund unless a written request for transfer to a siblings account (7th Grade and up) is received by the boosters before the end of June of the graduating year.
- ** Student funds will only be held one year should a student drop out of band but are still eligible to join band in a future year. Should the student not return to band after one year the money will then transfer to the Band Booster General Fund.

Requests for exceptions to this policy must be presented to and be approved by the Band Booster Executive Board prior to the scheduled Band Booster event.
